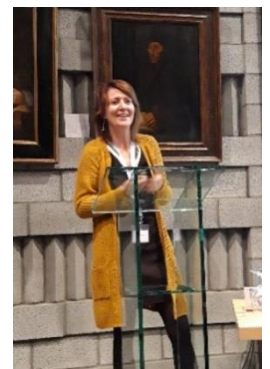


The meeting was kicked-off with a short **welcome and update about BBMRI.be** and its accomplishments in the last year by the President and National Node Director of BBMRI.be.
